

# Newcastle Clyde Street Former Gasworks Remediation Project

Community Notification 1 – Commencement of Remediation works  
September, 2019



## Commencement of Remediation Works - Site Establishment

Remediation works at the former Newcastle Clyde Street Gasworks site, located adjacent Clyde Street and Chatham Road, Hamilton North will commence from early September, following the receipt of the Project Development Consent from the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment on 18 July 2019.

The Newcastle Gas Company (former owner of the site, which is now owned by Jemena) operated the site as a gasworks from 1913 to 1985. The site is vacant and in a disused state, and the soil and groundwater at the site has been contaminated over the lifespan of use as a Gasworks for 72 years.

The duration of works is expected to take approximately 10 months (weather and site conditions dependant). The work will be undertaken in phases and Jemena will notify you of these works on a regular basis. *If you would prefer to receive email updates, please register at <https://haveyoursay.jemena.com.au>.*

The Remediation works will be managed by Jemena's Principal Contractor Ford Civil Contracting, an experienced contractor, who will be supported by many local suppliers and sub-contractors.

Site Mobilisation will commence from early September 2019 and will include:

- Set up of the Environmental & Safety controls;
- Vegetation and Tree clearing;
- Establishment of site compound & parking;
- Construction of a temporary new driveway (to the north) and reinforcement of existing driveway (to the south);
- Demolition of (non-heritage) buildings/infrastructure on the site (*Heritage buildings/structures will remain and will be protected during the works*); and
- On-site encapsulation of asbestos building materials. This activity will comply with all regulatory requirements, using stringent environmental controls by Jemena's experienced and licensed contractor.

You may notice an increase in noise and vehicle movements during the work, however, every effort will be made to minimise the impact of the work on the community.
